This academic year (2019-2020) there were a number of items accomplished and discussed during our SLOA committee meetings. They are as follows:

- Reports in eLumen were made available to the IIC committee and will continue to be made available as necessary for accreditation purposes.
- Recommendation from SLOA committee (per IIC) to recommend, support, promote, and
  encourage all divisions/departments to follow a 2-level assessment scale (Meets and Does not
  Meet) when doing SLOAs. Justification for this is as follows: Consistent assessment scales/tools
  in eLumen will lead to more accurate and reliable information from eLumen. A 2-level
  assessment scale is what most departments and divisions use currently thus the impact should
  be minimum to most divisions as it is implemented gradually.
- SLOA website has been updated with current contact information.
- Alignment of Program Review Cycle and SLOA cycle has been approved by the SLOA committee
  to move forward. Our current 3-year SLOA cycle ended this year. We will now be aligned with
  the Program Review Cycle which runs from 2020 to 2023 if approved by PRC.
- Recommended draft revisions/redesign of the 14 ISLOs has been forwarded to the Redesign Committee and the appropriate Guided Pathway teams. Our intentions are to streamline the ISLOs.
- Elumen TEST site has been configured to allow CSLOs to map to PSLOs and PSLOs to map to ISLOs. Currently CSLOs are mapped directly to ISLOs in eLumen.
- Student Evaluation folders are now available when completing SLO assessments. This will allow faculty to upload information for each student independently as necessary.
- Current year to date eLumen statistics as of (5-4-20) are as follows:
  - Courses without CSLO's-All completed
  - Unmapped CSLO's-168 out of 3,638 courses
  - CSLO's Not Included In Any Assessment Rubrics- 511 out of 3,638 courses
- We are currently looking at a project to allow eLumen to be accessed in Canvas to facilitate faculty input of assessments. On hold due to Corvid-19.
- Data uploads from district banner occurred 3 times per semester.
