- 2. Issues regarding CSLO
 - a. The duplicate SLO problem has been eliminated by eLumen
 - b. Final data upload for Fall 2019 semester is complete
 - c. Counseling course with only 2 students showing problem solved per George
 - d. Reflections "how to" link appears to be dead on the SLO website
- 3. Discussion of re-working ISLOs to better fit Guided Pathways goals
 - a. Quick recap of the discussion held at Nov. 1 meeting that included guests from the various Guided Pathway workgroups
 - b. Discussion of the draft document George generated following the Nov. 1 meeting titled "Institutional Student Competencies (Revision of the title from ISLOs to ISC)
 - i. Competency vs outcome
 - ii. NACE (Nat'l Assoc. of Colleges and Employers) college + industry collaboration
 - iii. Most colleges per George's research have 4-8 institutional competencies/outcomes listed
 - c. How are ISLOs currently assessed?
 - i. CSLOs are mapped to ISLOs
 - ii. Institutional Effectiveness Committee (or IIE?) did a student survey prior to the last accreditation visit
 - iii. Accreditation team recommends that we do a better job assessing, discussing, and implementing what we have learned
 - d. Consensus of the committee members present the ISC (institutional student competencies) approach is a good one
 - i. Should they be detailed/"wordy" or kept simple, one word or short phrase?
 - ii. Assessment for some of the proposed ISCs will be difficult to do in the classroom
 - 1. Some are perhaps better assessed by staff, student support offices, counseling, campus climate surveys, etc.
 - 2. Guided Pathways Workgroup 4 (is learning happening) is discussing program outcomes perhaps PSLO assessments/portfolios provide opportunities for ISLO/ISC assessment
 - e. Committee members need to get all comments to George by Dec. 13
 - i. Comments and/or recommendations regarding the proposed ISCs

 - ii. Ideas for the assessment of some/all of the ISCs
