Meeting Minutes for 3-3-23 SLOAC meeting

The following is a brief summary of the meeting minutes for the SLOA meeting on 4-7-23 (written by George Bonnand for the 4-7-23 SLOAC meeting).

Meeting came to order at approximately 12:03 PM. Present members are listed below:

Present for meeting: Caleb Petrie; Toni Nielson; George Bonnand; Deanna Smedley; Alix Plum; Michael Mueller; Anna Shyrokova; Karin Pavelek.

Members missing from the meeting: Phat Truong; Matt Tribbe; Wendy Perez, Ben De Guzman (student representative), and Bradley Dawson.

Meeting came to order at approximately 12:05PM

Meeting agenda for 4-7-23 and meeting minutes for 3-3-23 were approved by the committee.

George Bonnand shared his screen and when over the presentation that Elumen presented on March 16th. In essence, there are a few enhancements that are on the horizon for Elumen. They are as follows:

- Simplified search box with key filters
- Newly column to display what course the assessment is "Used In"
- Flagging for deactivated SLOs

George Bonnand showed the "Inbox" features and explained some of the new features. The "Test" site in Elumen has the new configuration with the enhancements. The new configuration with be in the "PROD" site in mid-June.

Deanna Smedley asked if the new configuration could have affected the "PROD" site? Deanna stated that the "Recommended" SLOs are no longer at the beginning of the selection list when the user goes to the "Find Assessment" tab. She stated that the entire library is showing now as opposed to just the recommended current SLOs.

George Bonnand stated that he did not know that it has affected the PROD Elumen site but that he would ask Elumen if it has affected the site.

George Bonnand then moved on the "Preferred Practices" SLOA Handbook revisions. Changes that have been made were reviewed with the committee. No objectives to changes were made during the meeting. 11:38

Karin Pavelek asked an unrelated question regarding assessment of courses for instructors who are no longer teaching in the middle of the semester. George Bonnand stated that the person taking over the course for this semester or the person taking over the course next semester would be the person doing the evaluation. However, if no information is handed over from the previous instructor it may be that the course is not evaluated this semester. George Bonnand stated he could help assign an evaluator if necessary to the course should that be necessary.

George Bonnand stated he would keep on working on the Preferred Practice handbook. 17:50

George Bonnand when on to the Elumen Report Status. Caleb Petrie stated that there was a problem with the Report Explorer function for approximately 2 weeks. As of last week, the issue has been resolved. There is one other report issue, but this is being worked out currently.

George Bonnand when on to the Mapping issues in Elumen 19:10. It appears that some courses have never been offered hence they are not listed in Banner and consequently are not in Elumen and cannot be mapped. If courses are offered, then they will be in Banner and will be in Elumen however some courses may be "inactive" and will not show up. This can be readily fixed by going into the "Org Management" tab and finding the course and then clicking on the Edit button. Once in the Edit mode it can be made "active" using the appropriate drop-down menu. If a course has never been offered, then it cannot be mapped. George Bonnand asked that everyone do the best they can with the mapping process. 20:50

George Bonnand moved on to PSLO updates. Karin Pavelek had some PSLOs for religious studies for curriculum review and approval. These PSLOs should be on the agenda for the 4-19-23 curriculum meeting. The Business PSLOs were submitted by Phat Truong and were approved at the 4-5-23 curriculum meeting. George Bonnand thanked everyone for doing these PSLOs. Most of the PSLOs that were on the list have been completed however some departments are resistant to changing the PSLOs. George Bonnand stated that this is fine we cannot force any department to change. 23:10 George Bonnand stated he would update the PSLO Timeline document showing which programs have been updated and send it out to everyone. (At last count as of 4-8-23 we 155/266 completed). Alix Plum asked for an updated list of the PSLO Timeline. 24:16

George Bonnand asked for updates from the Team Leaders on PSLOs. Michael Mueller stated that he was working on his and that he should have them to me shortly.

Deanna Smedley made a comment regarding the PSLOs and whether it should be part of the SLOA Preferred Practices Handbook or is the canvas page on PSLOs sufficient? The question was posed to the committee for comments and feedback. A discussion ensued between committee members regarding where the responsibility for PSLOs should fall. 29:11 The PSLO rubric was approved by the senate. George Bonnand stated that he would put verbiage into the Preferred Practices handbook which addresses the PSLOs. Comments from committee members would be welcomed on the verbiage.

33:36 Alix Plum made a request that we have a review training session to update/refresh the members on Elumen navigation and usage. These meetings could either be after our current meetings or on Fridays when there are no other SLOA meetings. A discussion among committee members ensued regarding this reinforcing the need for these review sessions. A date of the beginning of May was picked hence at our next scheduled meeting (5-5-23) we will have a session.

George Bonnand asked that members send him a listing of topics that they would like covered so that preparations can be made.

Meeting was adjourned at 12:44 PM.
