IV. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Deanna Smedley reminded senators that Major Declaration Day will be 19-Mar.

Matt Taylor encouraged faculty to participate in the Major Declaration Project. He reported that 6,500 students have visited the Hornet Pathways website to view program maps, and 1,000 students have visited the site a 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> time. Five-hundred and fifty-nine students clicked the link on the site to then register for classes, and 457 clicked the link to schedule an appointment with a counselor. He also reported that 1,200 kudos were sent to students to students.

Naveen Kanal reminded senators that the FC Men's Basketball team has a home play-off game on 9-Mar at 6P.

Gilberto Valencia informed the Senate that volunteers are still needed for KinderCaminata. He reminded senators about the Two Spirit Presentation on 20-Mar, and the events taking place during Women's Herstory Month.

Daniel Berumen reported that an email had gone out to faculty with information about the Financial Aid audit process and emails will begin going out today to faculty who need to validate grades and last day of academic activity.

He will be repeating this announcement, probably for the rest of the semester.
